

Oak Hill Union Local School District Public Records Rights

The Board of Education supports the right of the people to know about the programs and services of their schools. It is the policy of the Board that openness leads to a better informed citizenry.

Public records are available by request during regular business hours at the Oak Hill Union Local School District's administrative offices .

A written request is not required for a public record, but is helpful in an effort for staff to expedite your request.

Requests must allow for a reasonable time to provide records for inspection.

Staff will advise of any denials or redactions to your request and must cite the reason and legal authority.

Fees charged will be actual costs of copying, as indicated in the current board policy.
